Opening Comments:

Hello, everyone and thank you for calling into our weekly Transit Security Grant Program (TSGP) conference call for the fiscal year (FY) 2012 application cycle.

We have mentioned the following dates on previous calls, but wanted to remind you again that your SF-424 must be submitted into the grants.gov system by next Friday April 27, 2012. Your final completed applications with all required documents, including Investment Justifications (IJs) and detailed budgets, will need to be submitted through ND Grants by Friday May 4, 2012 no later than 11:59pm EDT.

We do know from past experience the submission systems may become overwhelmed with the volume of applications being submitted at one time. We strongly encourage you to test your log in and passwords prior to the submission deadline. If you find that you are having log in issues or submission problems please contact your FEMA program analyst for assistance. If you are in a position to submit your applications early there is no reason to wait until the actual deadline, you can submit them at any time.

If you are interested in attending the National Homeland Security Conference (UASI Conference) which is being held in Columbus, Ohio May 22 through May 24, the early registration cut-off date has been extended to May 1, 2012.
