Opening Comments:

TSA: Hello, everyone. Thank you for calling in. This is our monthly conference call. We have a few updates to provide before questions. As many of you know we had a tentative release date of May 10th for the FY11 TSGP (Transit Security Grant Program) Grant Guidance. Based on information we have just received and due to issues that our outside of our control it appears that the guidance will not be released any earlier than May 17th, which is one week later than anticipated. FEMA is actively working on rescheduling the workshops that we initially scheduled for May 12th in Chicago, IL, May 13th in Dallas, TX and May 17th in Oakland, CA. Once confirmation is received as to the new dates, locations and times notices will be immediately sent out.

As many of you are probably aware due to the delay in appropriations, once the grant guidance is released you should expect a compressed timeline for submittal of applications.
