

TSGP Conference Call Summary

Opening Comments:

Hello, everyone thank you for calling into our monthly Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Transit Security Grant Program (TSGP) conference call.

Hopefully you are aware that the FY 2011 TSGP Awards were announced on August 23rd, 2011. FEMA issued Information Bulletin (IB) #370 that listed those agencies that are receiving awards. The IB was sent out by FEMA through ASKCSID (ASKCSID@dhs.gov) and TSA Grants through (TSAGrants@tsa.dhs.gov).

Each grant recipient will be hearing from their FEMA budget analysts regarding the required updated budgets which need to reflect the grant award amount. Please respond quickly to these requests as we are endeavoring that no further conditions need to be met and you will not have to wait on the release of funds.

By the end of next week each grantee will receive a letter describing those projects that were funded and those that were not funded. This will enable you to adjust your detailed budgets for the submission of the finalized budget with the actual award amount.

We have scheduled two After Action Workshops (AAW), one on the west coast and one on the east coast.

- The west coast AAW will be held on September 28, 2011 in the FEMA Region IX offices located at 1111 Broadway, Suite 1200 in Oakland, CA 94607.
- The east coast AAW will be held on October 3, 2011 in the TSA Headquarters office located at 601 12th Street South Arlington, VA 20598.

Both are scheduled to start at 9am and if you plan on attending please send your registration information to ASKCSID (ASKCSID@dhs.gov) as these are federal buildings and access permissions are required.

We will be going over the same information in both workshops so you will not need to attend both. If you plan on attending you will be able to use your grant Management and Administration (M&A) funding. If you are unable to attend we will post the presentation on our website (<http://www.tsa.gov/grants>) so that you may see what was discussed. If you have suggestions you would like to submit they can be sent to ASKCSID (ASKCSID@dhs.gov) and TSA Grants (TSAGrants@tsa.dhs.gov).
