

TSGP Questions and Answers

Questions and Answers:

Q: Can a maintenance contract go beyond the 24 month period of performance (POP)?

A: No. It is intended that all funds be used within the POP.

Q: Can we receive feedback from our FY 2011 investment justification (IJ) submissions?

A: You should contact your FEMA program analyst for those discussions.

Q: Was the risk model updated for FY 2012?

A: Yes it was. Additional information on the update will be provided at the roll-out workshops.

Q: Can we receive our updated risk score?

A: Yes. That information is sensitive security information (SSI) and can be provided once finalized.

Q: Could maintenance of a vehicle purchased with FY 2006 grant funding be allowable as an FY 2012 IJ?

A: Yes, but keep in mind that would be a lower funding priority.

Q: Would a CCTV project for a station that is less than 50 years old be a potentially good project submission?

A: There would be a quicker environmental and historic preservation (EHP) review process, potentially allowing the project to be completed within the POP.

Q: Can previous year TSGP grant funds be used for maintenance & sustainment (M&S)?

A: Yes. It would be considered a reprogramming of funds, and should be requested through that process.

Q: Can we use funding to sustain OPack teams?

A: Yes, you can either apply for FY 2012 TSGP funds to sustain prior-year OPack teams, or reprogram prior year funding provided the proposal does not extend beyond the original POP.
