



School Bus Drivers

Watch for Suspicious ITEMS and BEHAVIOR

Characteristics of Suspicious Items:

- Abandoned or hidden in unusual place
- Leaking gas, vapor, odor or suspicious substance (including excessive grease)
- Contains exposed wires or timer
- Have an attached message with threatening note or suspicious marking

Suspicious Behavior Includes Persons:

- Abandoning item(s) and leaving quickly
- Showing an unusual interest in employees
- Being where they are not supposed to be
- Possessing a weapon or dangerous item
- Causing disruptions or distractions

If You See Suspicious Items and/or Behavior:

- **IMMEDIATELY** report suspicious items to 911
- Do **NOT** use radio or cell phone within 300 feet of item or device
- Pay attention to location of item or device
- Do **NOT** move or touch item or device

- Report location of scene
- Include physical appearance, gender and/or unusual characteristics
- Report clothing characteristics

Simple Security Tips :

- Perform Pre-Trip and Post-Trip Inspections of the vehicle
- Look for out of place items such as a canister, propane style tank, metal box, or bottle
- Do not leave the vehicle unlocked (if possible), unattended, or out of your sight
