Your safety is our priority

Airlines are now collecting additional passenger information as the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) implements **Secure Flight**, a program developed to allow for uniform watch list matching by TSA to identify known and suspected terrorists.

How will Secure Flight affect me?

Passengers must provide their **full name, date of birth, gender, and redress number** (if available)* to airlines to allow TSA to perform watch list matching. By providing this information in advance, most passengers will not experience any differences from the way they traveled before.

* Those who encounter misidentification are invited to apply for Redress at www.dhs.gov/trip to help prevent watch list matching misidentifications in the future.
