NOTE B: The Contracting Officer may, at any time, by written order to the Contractor, require the Contractor to stop all, or any part, of the work called for by this contract for a period of 90 days after the order is delivered to the Contractor, and for any further period to which the parties may agree. The order shall be specifically identified as a stop-work order issued against this contract. Upon receipt of the order, the Contractor shall immediately comply with its terms. Within a period of 90 days after a stop-work is delivered to the Contractor, or within any extension of that period to which the parties shall have agreed, the Contracting Officer shall either –

- 1) Cancel the stop work order, or –
- 2) Terminate the work covered by the order as provided in the termination for default or the termination for convenience clause of this contract.

If a stop-work order issued under this clause is cancelled or the period of the order or any extension thereof expires, the Contractor shall resume work.

If a stop-work order is not canceled and the work covered by the order is terminated by the Government, the Contractor shall honor said termination.

SECTION C – STATEMENT OF WORK

Inkjet and Laser Printer Cartridge Recycling

1. Introduction

1.1 Organization – Transportation Security Administration (TSA)

2. Project Background and Objectives

Executive Order 13101, Greening the Government through Waste Prevention, Recycling and Federal Acquisition, dated September 14, 1998, requires the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) to implement a waste prevention and recycling program at its facilities. It also calls for TSA's procurement of environmentally preferable products. TSA's Environmental Policy Statement establishes that while the "primary mission of TSA is to protect the security of the Nation's transportation systems"... that "a major strategy for accomplishing this mission is to protect communities and the natural environment affected by our transportation security activities." To this extent, TSA endeavors to establish a recycling program for printer cartridges at all TSA airport locations.

3. Technical Services Required

3.1 Task Description

The Vendor shall provide recycling services for inkjet and laser printer cartridges to all TSA occupied locations in and outside the Continental United States.

3.2 Scope of Work

The Vendor shall be responsible for storage, collection and ultimate recycling of inkjet and laser printer cartridges.

3.3 Statement of Work

3.3.1 Description

3.3.2 The Contractor shall deliver recycling containers to any TSA occupied location in or outside the Continental United States. The Contractor shall deliver the containers at no cost to the Government. The containers shall arrive with postage pre-paid so that they may be mailed back to the Contractor when full at no cost to the Government. The Contractor shall supply the recycling containers as described below:

- a. Plastic bags or cardboard boxes to collect inkjet cartridges
- b. Plastic bags or cardboard boxes to collect laser printer cartridges

The Contractor shall recycle all cartridges upon receipt of a full container from any TSA occupied location. The Contractor shall provide proof of recycling. No cost shall be incurred upon the Government in the completion of these tasks.

4. Deliverables

4.1 Itemized list and due dates

Containers shall be due to their specified location within 14 days of the receipt of the order by the Contractor.

4.2 Acceptance Criteria

Proof of recycling shall be verified by a Certificate of Completion in mutually acceptable Contractor format.

4.3 Delivery Instructions

The Government shall provide the location and instructions for delivery with each order for a TSA occupied location.

5. Government Furnished Resources

5.1 Facilities, Supplies and Services

Containers will be located in Government spaces at each TSA occupied location.

5.2 Information Sources

The Government will supply the location for delivery of each container.

5.3 Documentation

Proof of recycling shall be verified by a Certificate of Completion in mutually acceptable Contractor format.

6. Contractor Furnished Resources

6.1 Facilities, Supplies and Services

The Contractor shall supply all shipping containers, all postage required for the mailing of the containers and all labor provided to ship the containers to each TSA occupied location, receive the containers back from the airport/HQ/Field Office and ensure that the cartridges are recycled.

7. Administrative Considerations

7.2 Place of Performance/Work Location

Collection of the cartridges shall take place at specified TSA occupied locations. Recycling of the cartridges shall take place at the facility designated by the Contractor.

7.3 Hours of Work

Hours of work are not specified in this contract. Since this contract is at no cost to the Government, hours of work are to be set and regulated by the Contractor.

7.4 Period of Performance

The period of performance of this contract shall be a period of 60 months, from 1 September 2005 through 31 August 2010.

7.5 Other Direct Costs

This contract shall be performed at no cost to the Government. No costs are allowable, either direct or indirect that will result in a required expenditure by the Government.

8. Special Instructions

There are no special instructions required of the Contractor by the Government in the performance of this contract.

SECTION D - PACKAGING AND MARKING**D.1 Packaging**

Preservation, packaging, and packing for shipment or mailing of all work deliverable hereunder shall be in accordance with good commercial practice and adequate to insure acceptance by common carrier and safe transportation at the most economical rates.

D.2 Marking

- (a) Each package, report or other deliverable shall be accompanied by a letter or other document in mutually acceptable contractor format which:
 - (1) Identifies the contract by number under which the item is being delivered.
 - (2) Identifies the deliverable Item Number or Report Requirement.
- (b) A copy of the document required in paragraph (a) above shall be simultaneously provided to the contracting officer's technical representative in mutually acceptable contractor format.

SECTION E - INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

E.1 Contractor Inspection Requirements

The Contractor is responsible for performing or having performed all inspections and tests necessary to substantiate that the supplies or services furnished under this contract conform to contract requirements, including any applicable technical requirements for specified manufacturers' parts.

NOTE A: Evidence of acceptance of containers shall be the signature of a Government representative upon the shipping receipt for the containers.

NOTE B: Evidence of recycling shall be documented by the Contractor via a signed Certificate of Completion (C of C) in mutually acceptable contractor format. The C of C should be accompanied by an invoice/receipt for those cartridges that have been recycled. Receipt of a signed certificate of completion by the COTR shall constitute acceptance of recycling services.

SECTION F - DELIVERIES OR PERFORMANCE

F.1 Contract Period

The Base period of performance will be from September 1, 2005 to August 31, 2010. The total period of performance for this Contract shall not exceed five (5) years.

SECTION G - CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION DATA

G.1 Authority – Contracting Officer, Contracting Officer's Representative and Contractor's Project Manager

- a. Contracting Officer - The contracting officer for administration of this contract is Marvin Grubbs (571) 227-1581.
- b. The contracting officer is the only person authorized to make or approve any changes in any of the requirements of this contract. Notwithstanding any clauses contained elsewhere in this contract, the said authority remains solely with the contracting officer (see Section B for persons authorized to place no-cost orders against this contract). Any changes made by the contractor at the direction of any person other than the contracting officer will be considered to have been made without authority and no adjustment will be made in the contract price to cover any increase in cost incurred as a result of the change.
- c. Contracting Officer's Representative - The Contracting Officer's Technical Representative (COTR) for this basic contract is: Kathryn Jones (571) 227-1116.
- d. The COTR will represent the contracting officer in the administration of technical details within the scope of this contract. The COTR is also responsible for the final inspection and acceptance of all reports, and such other responsibilities as may be specified in the contract. The COTR is not otherwise authorized to make any representations or commitments of any kind on behalf of the contracting officer or the Government. The COTR does not have authority to alter the contractor's obligations or to change the contract specifications, price, terms or conditions. If, as a result of technical discussions, it is desirable to modify contract obligations or the statement of work, changes will be issued in writing and signed by the contracting officer. The Government may change the COTR assignment for this contract at any time without prior notice to the contractor. The contractor will be notified of the change.

- f. The contractor shall provide a Project Manager for this contract that has the authority to make any no-cost contract technical, hiring and dismissal decisions, or special arrangement regarding this contract. The Project Manager shall be responsible for the overall management and coordination of this contract and shall act as the central point of contact with the Government. The Project Manager shall have full authority to act for the contractor in the performance of the required services. The Project Manager, or a designated representative, shall meet with the COTR to discuss problem areas as they occur. The Project Manager or designated representative shall respond within four hours after notification of the existence of a problem. The Project Manager shall be able to fluently read, write, and speak the English language.

G.2 Payment Schedule

This is a no-cost contract to the Government. The Contractor will not submit invoices to the Government. Invoices submitted to the Government in performance of this no-cost contract will be rejected.

SECTION H – SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

H.1 News Releases

The contractor shall obtain explicit, written consent from the contracting officer before making reference to the equipment or services furnished pursuant to the provisions of this contract in any news release or commercial advertising, or in connection with any news release or commercial advertising.

H.2 Disclosure of Information –Official Use Only

- a. Any TSA Information made available or to which access is provided, and which is marked or should be marked "Official Use Only", shall be used only for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this contract and shall not be divulged or made known in any manner to any person except as may be necessary in the performance of the contract. Disclosure to anyone other than an officer or employee of the contractor or subcontractor at any tier shall require prior written approval of the TSA. Requests to make such disclosure should be addressed to the TSA contracting officer.
- b. Each officer or employee of the contractor or subcontractor at any tier to whom "Official Use Only" information may be made available or disclosed shall be notified in writing by the contractor that "Official Use Only" information disclosed to such officer or employee can be used only for the purpose and to the extent authorized herein, and that further disclosure of any such "Official Use Only" information, by any means, for a purpose or to an extent unauthorized herein, may subject the offender to criminal sanctions imposed by 18 U.S.C. Sections 641 and 3571. Section 641 of 18 U.S.C. provides, in pertinent part, that whoever knowingly converts to his use or the use of another, or without authority sells, conveys, or disposes of any record of the United States or whoever receives the same with the intent to convert it to his use or gain, knowing it to have been converted, shall be guilty of a crime punishable by a fine or imprisoned up to 10 years or both.
- c. Contractor employees, prior to beginning work, shall sign a non-disclosure agreement to be furnished to the contracting officer.

H.3 Organizational Conflicts of Interest

- a. The Contractor warrants that, to the best of the Contractor's knowledge and belief, there are no relevant facts or circumstances which could give rise to an organizational conflict of interest (OCI), or that the Contractor has disclosed all such relevant information.
- b. The Contractor agrees that if an actual or potential OCI is discovered after award, the Contractor shall make a full disclosure in writing to the CO. This disclosure shall include a description of actions, which the Contractor has taken or proposes to take, after consultation with the CO, to avoid, mitigate, or neutralize the actual or potential conflict.
- c. The CO may terminate this contract for convenience, in whole or in part, if it deems such termination necessary to avoid an OCI. If the Contractor was aware of a potential OCI prior to award or discovered an actual or potential conflict after award and did not disclose or misrepresented relevant information to the CO, the Government may terminate the contract for default, debar the Contractor from Government contracting, or pursue such other remedies as may be permitted by law or this contract.

H.4 Prohibition Against the Use of Federal Employees

Contracts are not to be awarded to Federal employees or a business concern or other organization owned or substantially owned or controlled by one or more Federal employees. For the purposes of this contract, this prohibition against the use of Federal employees includes any work performed by the contractor or any of its employees, subcontractors, or consultants.

H.5 Type of Contract

This is a no-cost contract.

H.6 Contract Terms and Conditions-Commercial Items

(a) *Inspection/Acceptance.* The Contractor shall only tender for acceptance those items that conform to the requirements of this contract. The Government reserves the right to inspect or test any supplies or services that have been tendered for acceptance. The Government may require repair or replacement of nonconforming supplies or re-performance of nonconforming services at no increase in contract price. The Government must exercise its post-acceptance rights-

- (1) Within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered or should have been discovered; and
- (2) Before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the item, unless the change is due to the defect in the item.

(b) *Changes.* Changes in the terms and conditions of this contract may be made only by written agreement of the parties.

(c) *Excusable delays.* The Contractor shall be liable for default unless nonperformance is caused by an occurrence beyond the reasonable control of the Contractor and without its fault or negligence such as, acts of God or the public enemy, acts of the Government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, unusually severe weather, and delays of common carriers. The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer in writing as soon as it is reasonably possible after the commencement of any excusable delay, setting forth the full particulars in connection therewith, shall remedy such occurrence with all reasonable dispatch, and shall promptly give written notice to the Contracting Officer of the cessation of such occurrence.

(d) *Patent indemnity.* The Contractor shall indemnify the Government and its officers, employees and agents against liability, including costs, for actual or alleged direct or contributory infringement of, or inducement to infringe, any United States or foreign patent, trademark or copyright, arising out of the performance of this contract, provided the Contractor is reasonably notified of such claims and proceedings.

(e) *Risk of loss.* Unless the contract specifically provides otherwise, risk of loss or damage to the supplies provided under this contract shall remain with the Contractor until, and shall pass to the Government upon:

- (1) Delivery of the supplies to a carrier, if transportation is f.o.b. origin; or
- (2) Delivery of the supplies to the Government at the destination specified in the contract, if transportation is f.o.b. destination.

(f) *Termination for the Government's convenience.* The Government reserves the right to terminate this contract, or any part hereof, for its sole convenience. In the event of such termination, the Contractor shall immediately stop all work hereunder and shall immediately cause any and all of its suppliers and subcontractors to cease work.

(g) *Termination for cause.* The Government may terminate this contract, or any part hereof, for cause in the event of any default by the Contractor, or if the Contractor fails to comply with any contract terms and conditions, or fails to provide the Government, upon request, with adequate assurances of future performance. In the event of termination for cause, the Government shall not be liable to the Contractor

for any amount for supplies or services not accepted, and the Contractor shall be liable to the Government for any and all rights and remedies provided by law. If it is determined that the Government improperly terminated this contract for default, such termination shall be deemed a termination for convenience.

(h) *Title*. Unless specified elsewhere in this contract, title to items furnished under this contract shall pass to the Government upon acceptance, regardless of when or where the Government takes physical possession.

(i) *Warranty*. The Contractor warrants and implies that the items delivered hereunder are merchantable and fit for use for the particular purpose described in this contract.

(j) *Limitation of liability*. Except as otherwise provided by an express warranty, the Contractor will not be liable to the Government for consequential damages resulting from any defect or deficiencies in accepted items.

(k) *Other compliances*. The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, executive orders, rules and regulations applicable to its performance under this contract.

(l) *Compliance with laws unique to Government contracts*. The Contractor agrees to comply with 31 U.S.C. 1352 relating to limitations on the use of appropriated funds to influence certain Federal contracts; 18 U.S.C. 431 relating to officials not to benefit; 40 U.S.C. 327, *et seq.*, Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act; 41 U.S.C. 51-58, Anti-Kickback Act of 1986; 41 U.S.C. 265 and 10 U.S.C. 2409 relating to whistleblower protections; 49 U.S.C. 40118, Fly American; and 41 U.S.C. 423 relating to procurement integrity.

SECTION I – CONTRACT CLAUSES

I.1 Ordering

(a) Any supplies and services to be furnished under this contract shall be ordered by written or electronic means by the individuals or activities designated in the Schedule. Such orders may be issued from September 1, 2005 through August 31, 2010.

(b) All delivery orders or task orders are subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. In the event of conflict between a delivery order or task order and this contract, the contract shall control.

(c) If mailed, an order is considered "issued" when the Government deposits the order in the mail. Orders may be issued by facsimile or by electronic commerce methods only if authorized in the Schedule.

I.2 Non-Personal Services (August 2002)

(a) As stated in the Federal Register, Volume 57, No. 190, page 45096, dated September 30, 1992, Policy Letter on Inherently Governmental Functions, no personal services shall be performed under this contract. No Contractor employee will be directly supervised by the Government in a manner that creates an employee-employer relationship. The Contractor employee's supervisor shall give all Contractor employee assignments and daily work direction. If any Contractor employee believes any Government action or communication has been given that would create a personal services relationship between the Government and a Contractor employee, the Contractor shall promptly notify the Contracting Officer (CO).

(b) The Contractor shall not perform any inherently governmental actions under this contract. No Contractor employee shall hold him or herself out to be a Government employee, agent, or representative. No Contractor employee shall state orally or in writing at any time that he or she is acting on behalf of or making decisions for the Government. In all communications with third parties in connection with this contract, Contractor employees shall identify themselves as Contractor employees and specify the name of the company for which they work. In all communications with other Government Contractors in connection with this contract, the Contractor employee shall state that they have no authority to in any way change the contract and that if the other Contractor believes this communication to be a direction to change their contract, they should notify the CO for that contract and not carry out the direction until a clarification has been received from the CO.

(c) Nothing in this clause shall limit the Government's rights in any way under any other provision of the contract, including those related to the Government's right to inspect and accept the services or supplies required under this contract.

I.3 3.8.2-17 Key Personnel and Facilities (February 2003)

(a) The personnel and/or facilities as specified below are considered essential to the work being performed hereunder and may, with the consent of the contracting parties, be changed from time to time during the course of the contract.

(b) Prior to removing, replacing, or diverting any of the specified personnel and/or facilities, the Contractor shall notify in writing, and receive consent from, the Contracting Officer reasonably in advance of the action and shall submit justification (including proposed substitutions) in sufficient detail to permit evaluation of the impact on this contract.

(c) No diversion shall be made by the Contractor without the written consent of the Contracting Officer.

(d) The key personnel and/or facilities under this contract are:

I.4 3.9.1-1 Contract Disputes (February 2003)

All contract disputes arising under or related to this contract shall be resolved through the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) dispute resolution system at the FAA Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (ODRA) and shall be governed by the procedures set forth in 14 C.F.R. Parts 14 and 17, which are hereby incorporated by reference. Judicial review, where available, will be in accordance with 49 U.S.C. 46110 and shall apply only to final agency decisions. A contractor may seek review of a final TSA decision only after its administrative remedies have been exhausted.

(b) The filing of a contract dispute with the ODRA may be accomplished by mail, overnight delivery, hand delivery, or by facsimile. A contract dispute is considered filed on the date it is received by the ODRA.

(c) Contract disputes are to be in writing and shall contain:

- (1) The contractor's name, address, telephone and fax numbers and the name, address, telephone and fax numbers of the contractor's legal representative(s) (if any) for the contract dispute;
- (2) The contract number and the name of the Contracting Officer;
- (3) A detailed chronological statement of the facts and of the legal grounds for the contractor's positions regarding each element or count of the contract dispute (i.e., broken down by individual claim item), citing to relevant contract provisions and documents and attaching copies of those provisions and documents;
- (4) All information establishing that the contract dispute was timely filed;
- (5) A request for a specific remedy, and if a monetary remedy is requested, a sum certain must be specified and pertinent cost information and documentation (e.g., invoices and cancelled checks) attached, broken down by individual claim item and summarized; and
- (6) The signature of a duly authorized representative of the initiating party.

(d) Contract disputes shall be filed at the following address:

(e) A contract dispute against the TSA shall be filed with the ODRA within two (2) years of the accrual of the contract claim involved. A contract dispute by the TSA against a contractor (excluding contract disputes alleging warranty issues, fraud or latent defects) likewise shall be filed within two (2) years after the accrual of the contract claim. If an underlying contract entered into prior to the effective date of this part provides for time limitations for filing of contract disputes with the ODRA which differ from the aforesaid two (2) year period, the limitation periods in the contract shall control over the limitation period of this section. In no event will either party be permitted to file with the ODRA a contract dispute seeking an equitable adjustment or other damages after the contractor has accepted final contract payment, with the exception of TSA claims related to warranty issues, gross mistakes amounting to fraud or latent defects. TSA claims against the contractor based on warranty issues must be filed within the time specified under applicable contract warranty provisions. Any TSA claims against the contractor based on gross mistakes amounting to fraud or latent defects shall be filed with the ODRA within two (2) years of the date on which the TSA knew or should have known of the presence of the fraud or latent defect.

(f) A party shall serve a copy of the contract dispute upon the other party, by means reasonably calculated to be received on the same day as the filing is to be received by the ODRA.

(g) After filing the contract dispute, the contractor should seek informal resolution with the Contracting Officer.

(h) The TSA requires continued performance with respect to contract disputes arising under this contract, in accordance with the provisions of the contract, pending a final TSA decision.

(i) The TSA will pay interest on the amount found due and unpaid from (1) the date the Contracting Officer receives the contract dispute, or (2) the date payment otherwise would be due, if that date is later, until the date of payment. Simple interest on contract disputes shall be paid at the rate fixed by the Secretary of the Treasury that is applicable on the date the Contracting Officer receives the contract dispute and then at the rate applicable for each 6-month period as fixed by the Treasury Secretary until payment is made.
