## Program mission

The First Observer Plus™ Program provides transportation professionals with the knowledge needed to recognize suspicious or criminal activity that may be related to terrorism, guidance in assessing what they see, and a method for reporting those observations.

## Observe

- If you see something that “Doesn’t Look Right” (a “DLR”), perform your job as you normally would, but report suspicious activities that you observe
- Remember First Observer Plus™ does not grant you any additional authority or permissions

## Assess the situation or observation based on:

- Your workplace experience and awareness
- Your job knowledge
- Any suspicious activity reporting training you have received

## Report

Your safety is a priority, so follow your company guidelines in reacting or responding to an incident. When safe to do so, report suspicious situations that may be criminal or terrorism related.

- First Observer Plus™ does not supercede your company guidelines or procedures for reporting suspicious activity, situation, or items
- Call 9-1-1 if police or EMS response is needed
- If a non-emergency, call TSA at 1-844-TSA-FRST (1-844-872-3778) or report to another recognized tip line
- Calls can be anonymous

TSA conducts immediate as well as long term analysis of all calls received, and shares the information with other federal, state, and local agencies.



## Effective reporting of suspicious activity or threats

When reporting suspicious activities or threats to government or law enforcement authorities, provide as much information and detail as possible to help answer the following basic questions:

- Who – description of person(s)
- What – description of suspicious activity
- Where – location of observation
- When – time/date of observation
- Why – if known

## Together we can make a difference

- ✓ Remain vigilant.
- ✓ Take notice of suspicious, unusual behaviors – not a person’s physical appearance
- ✓ Use your knowledge, judgment and experience
